**Review text:**

In a way falsifying the statements on duality involving ARBITRARY exchange statistics in the model proposed on pp. 4579 - 4592 of the same journal volume (cf. also MR 2065 946), the authors report the existence of a three-body counterexample where certain consistency requirements prove fulfilled only for bosons or fermions. Then, their use of the coordinate Bethe ansatz is explained NOT to imply the originally declared exact solvability of their model.
